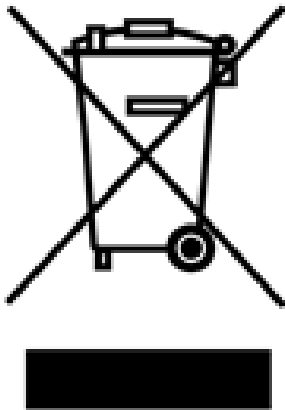


ESI WEEE Policy Statement

The Waste Electric and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 became law in the UK on the 1st of January 2014 and replaced the 2006 Regulations. The regulations transpose the main provisions of Directive 2012/19/EU on WEEE which recasts the previous Directive 2002/96/EC.

These regulations require that, when disposing of electrical and electronic equipment at the end of its useful life, it must be recycled and/or disposed of in accordance with the directive. Products that are obligated are marked with the following symbol.
